Currently, Home Office documents such as: Working together to protect crowded places, Crowded places: the planning system and counterterrorism, and Protecting crowded places: design and technical issues, outline advice for local authorities, police, businesses, planners and architects to reduce vulnerability in crowded places.

Core to these strategies is developing an integrated analysis that links mass gatherings and infrastructure giving designers, owners and operators information on issues relating to generic threats and vulnerabilities associated with the built environment and public gatherings.
